Kansas District and Appellate Court COVID-19 Personnel Policies

The judicial branch has implemented COVID-19 policies since the beginning of the pandemic in March of 2020. At this stage in the pandemic, less COVID-19 specific policies are needed. This document explains COVID-19-specific personnel policies still in place. These policies should be read in conjunction with the Kansas Court Personnel Rules.

Isolation and Masking

Kansas district and appellate courts must follow the guidance for isolation and masking at the following link: <u>Isolation and Precautions for People with COVID-19 | CDC.</u>

The current CDC guidance closely tracks with our prior COVID-19 Exposure, Leave Benefits, and Return to Work Guide and eliminates the need to update judicial branch policy if CDC guidance changes.

As a reminder, currently, COVID-19 exposure alone no longer requires quarantine, but employees must take other precautions like wearing a high-quality mask.

COVID-19 Sick Leave

The judicial branch will provide COVID-19 Sick Leave through December 31, 2023, for eligible employees, as set out in the Coronavirus-19 Leave Options and Procedures policy.
